From Route 29 (Columbia Pike) travel to Route 108 (Clarksville Pike) West.

Travel 0.4 miles. You will pass a traffic light at Columbia Rd.

You will see a sign saying "Centennial Park East Entrance."

This is Woodland Rd. Turn right.

Make an immediate left into the park entrance. Pavilion H is at the end of the park road.

There are multiple parking lots.

From Interstate I -95 travel to Exit #43- Route 100 West. Take 100 West to 29 South. Follow directions above.
